

## Tips for keeping your fish and pond healthy through winter:

- Trim off dead plant material that might hang over into the pond
- Skim out any leaves and debris that have fallen into the pond
- It's ok to turn off your UV light until spring
- Put a **net** over the pond at least until the last of the leaves have fallen
- Continue adding bacteria to your pond, but switch to **cold** water formula
- When the temperature in the water gets below 60 degrees, start feeding winter food until the water gets below 50 degrees. Then stop feeding the fish all together.
- For large lake pond owners, you can shut down your aerators approximately November-March (warm weather will decide when to start them back up).

This is also a good time to inspect the diffusers to make sure they're free of algae and debris and change the air filter on your pump if you live in a particularly dusty area.

You can stop using water treatments on large lake ponds and start back up in the spring with **1 or 5lb Pond** (bacteria) **Blocks**.
